

Minimum Efficacy Requirements

All OLED luminaire submissions have a panel efficacy of at least 35 lumens/watt, including driver losses.

Other Requirements

Please note that these are minimum requirements and judges will award more point to higher performing products (such as products with higher efficacy and higher CRI). See the Judging Criteria below for more details.

- Allowable CCTs: 2700 - 3500 K
- Allowable CRI (minimum): Interior - 80; Exterior - 75

For Connected Lighting - see the separate guidance document for this category.

Judging Criteria

Judges will score each entry according to the following criteria:

- Color appearance
- Color rendering
- Appropriate light output and distribution
- Application efficiency
- Value
- Aesthetic appearance and style
- Ease of installation
- Innovation

Potential Bonus Points

The judging panel may award bonus points for entries exhibiting desirable characteristics. Bonus points will be available for the attributes listed below; additional bonus points may be identified by the judges.

- Senior friendly
- Sustainability
- Ability to change color
- Connected lighting
- Dimmability
- Replaceable components
